\$30,000 Matching Fund Drive is On

All donations to CPCR will be matched from now until December 31 at midnight.

We've once again set a goal of raising \$60,000 in November and December 2024. We pray that you would consider giving towards these projects that we've established for 2024:

- 1. Backpack for each child full of food supplies and a gospel storybook for children Cost \$20,000
- 2. Electrical Update along with a paved road to the camp, we soon will have public electricity. In addition to connecting to the new power lines via underground wiring, we also will be updating our

current electrical system with more solar panels and repairs to our existing electrical wiring system. Cost - \$18,000

3. Farm Improvements – We are so grateful for your donations several years ago to our Farmer

John Ag Center. We are currently getting a permit to build. Then, we want to furnish it by pur-



chasing some animals. Cost - \$12,000

4. Building Upkeep - \$10,000.

7 Youth from Canada help with many projects



We praise the Lord that our mission house is getting a lot of use. We recently had a mission team of 7 youth visit us from the Toronto, Canada area. They participated in many activities including building a raised garden bed with the local school children (see the picture below), planting nearly 200 shrubs both at the camp and at a partner ministry in Puntarenas that sends children to the camp, teaching English to adults and children at Paul and Thelma's local church in Esparza, and leading a day camp with local children. They led 8 people to the Lord, 6 children and 2 adults.



The Backpack pictured below with the 2024 theme logo on it will be packed with food supplies and a child's Gospel Storybook. Each child will receive this backpack as a gift for the family.







In September, the camp housed the Costa Rica Special Needs National Soccer Team, who went on to win the tournament in Mexico in October. Congratulations to them!
